Topic:

Integrating Sustainability in Capital Budgeting Decisions

There is evidence that most firms do not consider environmental impacts in capital budgeting decision making and analysis. Furthermore, there are many hidden sustainability related costs that are "buried" in overhead and in general expenses that are not captured in current capital budgeting analysis.

In this lecture Professor Kimbro will discuss a practical approach for capital budgeting that incorporates sustainability and environmental analysis into decision making by evaluating eco-efficiency (EE) analysis through Life-Cycle-Assessment (LCA), life-cycle costing (LCC) and Full-Cost Accounting (FCA) techniques.
